Central Pollution Control Board (CPCB) is executing a project entitled “Water Quality Monitoring System for River Ganga” under the Institutional Development Component of the World Bank Assisted “National Ganga River Basin Project”. The project envisages establishment of a network of Real Time Water Quality Monitoring stations at identified locations along the main stem of River Ganga by vendors / instruments manufacturers / suppliers at their own cost including operation and maintenance of the equipments / instruments installed at these stations. The real time data generated at these stations will be provided online to CPCB on payment basis.

To move forward on this initiative, CPCB is organizing an interactive meet on 2nd September, 2013 with agencies and service providers involved in real-time water quality monitoring of rivers. The objective of the meeting is to share experience of various agencies in establishing and operating large network of real-time water quality monitoring stations and also to understand the requirement of CPCB.
