# NATIONAL GANGA RIVER BASIN PROJECT (INDIA) (WORLD BANK FUNDED)

### **INVITATION FOR BIDS (IFB)**

**International Competitive Bidding (ICB)** 

- 1. The invitation for Bid follows the General Procurement Notice for this Project that appeared in UNDB online on 30.03.2011 & updated last on 31.01.2014.
- 2. The National Ganga River Basin Authority (NGRBA), Ministry of Water Resources, River Development & Ganga Rejuvenation (MoWR, RD & GR), Government of India has received financing of US\$ 1 billion from the World Bank towards the cost of the National Ganga River Basin Project and intends to apply a part of the proceeds towards payments under the contract for work detailed below. The project for setting up of Real Time Water Quality Monitoring System for River Ganga is being executed by the Central Pollution Control Board (CPCB) under the overall supervision of the National Mission for Clean Ganga (NMCG), the dedicated agency for implementation of NGRBA programme under MoWR, RD & GR.
- 3. Qualification requirements as listed briefly below are required to be fulfilled by the bidder. [Bidders are advised to refer to the bidding documents for complete details]

#### Financial:

- a) The minimum average annual turnover in Supply, Installation, commissioning, operation and maintenance of environmental monitoring equipment in the last five years (2010-11, 2011-12, 2012-13, 2013-14 and 2014-15) shall be USD\$2 million or INR 130 million
- b) The minimum amount of liquid assets and/or credit facilities net of other contractual commitments of the successful Bidder shall be US\$2 million or INR 130 million.

#### Technical:

- c) The experience required to be demonstrated by the Bidder should include as a minimum that he has successfully executed at least one contract of value US\$ 1.5 million or INR 100 million or two contracts aggregating to US\$ 1.5 million or INR 100 million for supply of Real Time Water Quality or Hydrological or Metrological (which must include precipitation data) Monitoring Data during the last 7 years.
- 4. Bidding will be conducted through the International Competitive Bidding Procedure as specified in the World Bank's <u>Guidelines: Procurement of Goods, Works and Non-consulting Services under IBRD Loans and IDA Credits & Grants, January 2011, revised July, 2014, and is open to all eligible bidders as defined in the Guidelines. In addition, please refer to paragraphs 1.6 and 1.7 of the Guidelines setting forth the World Bank's policy on conflict of interest.</u>
- 5. Member Secretary, CPCB for and on behalf of the Purchaser invites sealed bids from eligible bidders for the services detailed in the table below. The bidders may submit bids for the following as per requirement given in the bidding document.

- 6. Interested eligible bidders may obtain further information from and inspect the bidding documents at the office of Mr. Suneel Dave, Additional Director & Incharge NGRBA Cell., at the address given below during the office hours i.e., 10.30 am to 5.00 pm.
- 7. A complete set of the bidding documents will be available on the CPCB website (<a href="http://cpcb.nic.in/Tenders.php">http://cpcb.nic.in/ngrba/ngrba.htm</a>) w.e.f. 14th September, 2015. The bidders who are interested to participate in the bidding process can download the bid documents from the website for their reference. However, bidders are advised to obtain the hard copy of the bidding document for preparation of their bids.
- 8. The bidders who download the documents from the website and use the same for submission of the bids should note that if there is any discrepancy between the downloaded document and the hard copy of the document issued to the bidders, the hard copy shall be treated as final and shall prevail over the downloaded documents.
- 9. The bidders who download the documents shall have to pay along with their bid submission, the non-refundable cost of Rs.15, 000/- including VAT or US \$230 in the form of a Certified Cheque/Demand Draft issued by a nationalized bank / foreign bank listed with the Reserve Bank of India having its branches in India, payable to the 'Central Pollution Control Board" payable at New Delhi.
- 10. Bidders can also purchase the bid documents commencing from 14<sup>th</sup> September, 2015 on payment of Rs. 15,000/-including VAT or US \$ 230 in the form of a Demand Draft issued by a nationalized bank/ foreign bank listed with the Reserve Bank of India having its branches in India, payable to the "Central Pollution Control Board" payable at New Delhi. Bid documents requested by post shall be sent through speed post/registered post on payment of an extra amount of Rs 4000/- or US\$ 60 for outside India and Rs. 2000/- within India. The Central Pollution Control Board will not be held responsible for the postal delay if any, in the delivery of the documents or non-receipt of the same.
- 11. The bidders may also note that the pre-bid proceedings, corrigendum if any will also be uploaded on the website mentioned hereinabove.

12. All bids must be accompanied by Bid Security of the amount specified in the table above, drawn in favour of 'Central Pollution Control Board'. Bids must be delivered to Central Pollution Control Board. Attn: Suneel Dave, Additional Director & Incharge NGRBA Cell on or before 15.00 hours (IST) on 29<sup>th</sup> October, 2015 at the address given below. Electronic bidding will not be permitted. Bids will be opened on the same day at 15.30 hours (IST), in the presence of the bidders' representatives who choose to attend. If the office happens to be closed on the date of receipt of the bids as specified, the bids will be received and opened on the next working day at the same time and venue. Late bids will be rejected.
